



individuals subject to the Act's reporting requirement. The Act requires that each public agency with a Conflict of Interest Code review and update its code at a minimum in even-numbered years under Government Code section 87306.5, and also as needed by changed circumstances under Government Code section 87306. When amendments to the Conflict of Interest Codes are necessary, the agency is responsible for submitting a revised Conflict of Interest Code to its reviewing agency. The Board of Supervisors is the reviewing body for the County entities and designated local entities listed above, under Government Code section 87303.

The Office of County Counsel in conjunction with the Office of Registrar of Voters has attached the following documents.: A) a list of County departments with revisions, a summary of revisions and supporting documents from each department; and B) a list of Solano County local agencies, a summary of revisions and supporting documents from each agency.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board can disapprove the amended Conflict of Interest Codes. However, this option is not recommended because 1) the Government Code requires the review of the Conflict of Interest Codes and submission of amendments to the Board; and 2) the amendments are appropriate.

**OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:**

The affected County department and designated local agencies listed above were involved in reviewing their Conflict of Interest Codes and submitting their revisions for approval to the Board of Supervisors through the Registrar of Voters with review by the County Counsel's Office.
