

1. General Compliance with ALUCP's.

- a. Prepare and send notification to the cities and county that the Travis Plan and Rio Vista Plan have been updated and each agency is required to bring their general plan into compliance with these updated Land Use Compatibility Plans. The ALUC expects it will conduct further review of plan consistency following 180 days unless circumstances warrant sooner.
- b. Organize a workshop for the cities and county to discuss ways of achieving compliance with the ALUCP's for the three airports.

2. Compliance with Wildlife Measures.

- a. Prepare and send notification to federal, state and local agencies with involvement in planning and implementing ecosystem restoration or enhancement of the possible conflicts these projects may have with the airport plans in Solano County.
- b. Establish CEQA thresholds of significance for wildlife hazards in the vicinity of airports.

Organize a regional conference on airport/ecosystem compatibility issues with relevant agencies and provide information on the possible conflicts these projects may have with the airport plans in Solano County.
