SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

The Sikh American community has over 25 million followers throughout the world, with a large group of Sikh's residing in Solano County and a Sikh Gurdwara located in Fairfield.

We would like to recognize and honor the Sikh American celebration of Vaisakhi, a historical and religious festival celebrated on April 14. The celebration marks the founding of the Sikh community in the 15th century.
