DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION:

Ms. Brice-Smith is a dedicated Eligibility Benefits Specialist II who is known for working quickly and prioritizing the needs of her clients. Ms. Brice-Smith's customer service skills are exemplary, and she is recognized as a team player who is always willing to volunteer to help her fellow coworkers. She is well liked and respected in the office and will be truly missed.

Ms. Brice-Smith retires from E&ES on May 3, 2019 and H&SS wishes her well in her retirement and future endeavors.
