SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Daniel Tolvvar started his career with the County of Solano working for the Department of Information Technology on October 26, 1998 as a Senior Systems Analyst. He was promoted to the Systems & Programming Manager role on March 13, 2005 and was later reclassified to Information Technology Manager on December 17, 2017.

Over the course of twenty-one years, Mr. Tolvvar has been a highly respected and valued member of Solano County. He has been a contributing team member and manager, a hard worker, and a leader to the Department of Information Technology staff. His last day of service is December 27, 2019, and he will be greatly missed by his friends and coworkers.
