DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION:

The Solano County Veterans Services Office (CVSO) recommends that the Board adopt and present a resolution recognizing November 11, 2020 as Veterans Day and to honor all Solano County residents who have served and are currently serving in the United States Armed Forces.
