## **RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING MARCH 24, 2026, AS AG DAY IN SOLANO COUNTY AND MARCH 15-21, 2026, AS AG WEEK NATIONWIDE**

**WHEREAS**, National Agriculture Day is recognized nationwide as a time to celebrate the abundance provided by agriculture, and each year farmers and ranchers, agricultural associations, businesses, educational institutions, government agencies, and community members join to promote and recognize the many contributions of agriculture; and

**WHEREAS**, in Solano County and throughout the nation, Ag Day will be celebrated on March 24, 2026, as part of National Agriculture Week, providing an opportunity to recognize the value of agriculture and honor the farmers and ranchers whose dedication helps feed our residents, our nation, and people around the world; and

**WHEREAS**, Ag Day and National Agriculture Week offer an opportunity for individuals to gain a deeper understanding of how food, fiber, and other agricultural products are produced, while encouraging appreciation for the vital role agriculture plays in sustaining a strong economy and healthy communities; and

**WHEREAS**, Solano County is recognized as one of the most agriculturally diverse counties in California, often cited as the second most diverse in the state, producing more than 80 to 90 crops and commodities, including almonds, nursery stock, cattle, processing tomatoes, wine grapes, and various seed crops; and

**WHEREAS**, agriculture encompasses approximately 67 percent of the land in Solano County, with commodities exported to 41 countries worldwide, contributing more than \$460 million annually to the local economy and supporting thousands of jobs in farming, processing, and related industries; and

**WHEREAS**, with its rich agricultural history and remarkable diversity, Ag Day and National Agriculture Week provide an ideal time for residents to learn more about agriculture and to celebrate the farmers and ranchers who are essential to Solano County's heritage, economy, and future.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes March 24, 2026, as Ag Day in Solano County and March 15-21, 2026, as Ag Week across the nation.
