



#### 2024-2025 K-12 student enrollment



2024-2025 K-12 students



OR

Schools eligible for additional targeted support and improvement (ATSI)

OR

Schools where 15
percent or more of the
teachers are holders of
a permit or certificate,
such as a temporary or
short-term permit, a
substitute permit, a
waiver, an intern
credential, or any other
authorization that is a
lesser certification than
a preliminary or clear
California teaching
credential

"The list of schools established pursuant to this section shall be reestablished in the 2024–25 fiscal year and again every three fiscal years thereafter. Each list shall be established in accordance with clause (ii), and shall be used for inspections beginning the following fiscal year."



#### 2024-2025 K-12 student enrollment




