RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING NOVEMBER 2025 AS NATIONAL CARE AT HOME MONTH ACKNOWLEDGING IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES HOME CARE WORKERS IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, the National Alliance for Care at Home recognizes each November as National Care at Home Month to celebrate various types of in-home care, including home health care, hospice care, palliative care, Medicaid Home and Community Based Services, and other types of home care for seniors or those living with serious disability or acute illness; and

WHEREAS, the Caregiver Action Network recognizes each November as National Family Caregivers Month honoring the unique role of caregivers who provide care to family members; and

WHEREAS, the California's In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program is nationally recognized as a leading model for consumer-directed home care and has influenced the design of similar programs in other states seeking to promote independence for people who need in-home assistance; and

WHEREAS, providing services and support to the disabled and elderly to remain living in their homes is a humane, dignified, and caring alternative to long-term care or institutional placement; and

WHEREAS, more than 7,000 IHSS home care workers provide home care services and support in Solano County, making it possible for approximately 7,200 eligible low-income disabled and elderly residents to remain living independently in their homes; and

WHEREAS, the work of Solano County's IHSS home care workers requires sensitivity, kindness, patience, commitment, dedication, and compassion; and

WHEREAS, the work of Solano County's IHSS home care workers is both physically demanding and emotionally challenging.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize the month of November 2025 as Solano County "National Care at Home Month."
