RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING MAY 17-23, 2026, AS NATIONAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES WEEK IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) are a vital public service; and

WHEREAS, EMS practitioners are professional medical providers who are ready to provide lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

WHEREAS, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, the EMS system consists of first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, emergency medical dispatchers, firefighters, police officers, educators, administrators, pre-hospital nurses, emergency nurses, emergency physicians, trained members of the public, and other out-of-hospital medical care providers; and

WHEREAS, the members of EMS teams, whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their lifesaving skills; and

WHEREAS, the Interstate Commission for EMS Personnel Practice also recognizes State EMS Offices, which serve as the lead state executive branch offices responsible for ensuring a coordinated systems approach to emergency medical services, overseeing the licensure of EMS personnel, administering the EMS system, and upholding public protection, thereby ensuring effective and responsive healthcare delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors in recognition of this event, does hereby adopt the week of May 17 - 23, 2026, as Emergency Medical Services Week, commemorating the 52nd Anniversary of EMS Week.
