RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HONORING CHRISTINE ROGERS, PRINCIPAL MANAGEMENT ANALYST, UPON HER RETIREMENT FROM COUNTY SERVICE, WITH NEARLY 21 YEARS OF SERVICE IN THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, Christine "Chris" Rogers began her distinguished career with Solano County on November 1, 2004, as an Entry Management Analyst in the County Administrator's Office, and through dedication and hard work was promoted over the years to Management Analyst – Journey, Senior, and ultimately Principal, a position she has held since December 2019; and

WHEREAS, prior to joining Solano County, Ms. Rogers earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Economics and Finance Administration and Master of Business Administration with a minor in Economics from Saint Mary's College, equipping her with the knowledge and skills that would serve the County well for more than two decades; and

WHEREAS, throughout her career, Ms. Rogers served as the County Administrator's Office liaison to numerous departments and agencies, including Agriculture, Auditor/Controller, Treasurer/Tax Collector, Assessor/Recorder, Human Resources, County Counsel, Child Support Services, Library, Department of Information Technology/Registrar of Voters, General Services, Nut Tree Airport, Veterans Services, District Attorney, Public Defender, First 5 Solano, Public Facilities Fees, LAFCo, East Vallejo Fire Protection District, and Health and Social Services; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Rogers played a vital role in many major County projects, including developing the framework for the County's budget document presentation (still in use today), updating to the Public Facilities Fees, supporting the Registrar of Voters Relocation Project, Agriculture Relocation Project, and Behavioral Health Residential Facility Project at the Beck campus, and coordinating the County's first Federal and State Legislative Platforms; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Rogers brought continuity and steadfast leadership to the County Administrator's Office, including during the COVID-19 pandemic; she served as the County's Legislative Coordinator between 2008 and 2010 where she also worked on federal earmarks, representing Solano County in Sacramento and Washington, D.C., and working closely with State and Federal lobbyists; and she contributed to the County receiving the Government Finance Officers Association's Distinguished Budget Presentation Awards for FY2008/09 and FY2009/10; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Rogers provided budgetary oversight and fiscal analysis for the County's largest department, Health and Social Services, with its \$530 million budget and more than 1,400 employees; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Rogers also valued team culture and community, ensuring the continuation of the annual "Food Fight" competition in 2005 with Contra Costa County to support local food banks, mentoring colleagues, and serving as the department's historian and go-to source for institutional knowledge; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Rogers will be remembered not only for her professionalism, integrity, and expertise, but also for her punctuality, dedication, and genuine enjoyment in working alongside colleagues and the Health and Social Services team; and

WHEREAS, Chris Rogers retires on October 4, 2025, after nearly 21 years of public service, looking forward to regular outdoor exercise and cherishing time with family and friends.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes and honors Christine Rogers for her outstanding service, invaluable contributions, and steadfast dedication to the residents of Solano County, and extends best wishes for a happy and fulfilling retirement.
