RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF MAY 12, 2026, AS JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) WEEK AND RECOGNIZING THE CADETS OF THE FAIRFIELD HIGH SCHOOL CA-032 AIR FORCE JROTC PROGRAM IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program at Fairfield High School, designated as the CA-32nd Cadet Corps and comprising 104 cadets, serves as a highly impactful leadership development and training program. It provides substantial and enduring benefits to participating student cadets while also making meaningful contributions to the greater Solano County community; and

WHEREAS, in the 2025–2026 school year, cadets contributed more than 4,386.75 hours of community service to Solano County, the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District (FSUSD), and Fairfield High School. In addition, they completed 1,449.75 hours of JROTC Leadership Development Requirement training in preparation for Color Guard/Sabre Team and Drill Team performances, as well as Corps participation in community events. These accomplishments were achieved while maintaining strong academic focus and active involvement in JROTC and other extracurricular activities; and

WHEREAS, the cadets supported numerous community and school-sponsored activities, including the Fairfield Coast and Creek Cleanup, the Rotary Club Pumpkin Patch Festival, the Special Olympics Games, and the Fairfield Adopt-A-Street Program, as well as multiple school-wide sporting events, festivals, and ceremonial functions; and

WHEREAS, the cadets demonstrated exceptional esprit de corps and teamwork—the hallmark of military tradition—through their participation in the 2025 Fairfield Veterans Day Parade; by performing Color Guard duties at numerous community civic ceremonies and FSUSD academic and student-focused events; and by hosting retired United States military veterans on campus for commemorative observances, including September 11 Commemoration Day, Veterans Day Tribute, Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, and Memorial Day ceremonies; and

WHEREAS, the cadets voluntarily participate in the Junior ROTC program, which provides instruction in Aerospace Science and Leadership while emphasizing personal responsibility, character development, discipline, and service to the school and community. Cadets are afforded leadership opportunities within the AFJROTC program, the school, and the broader community, where many assume key responsibilities. Through these experiences, cadets develop valuable skills that support their growth as engaged, responsible citizens and servant leaders; and

WHEREAS, the cadets of Fairfield High School, under the guidance and leadership of their dedicated instructors, Lt Col Frank B. Aguon, Jr., Senior AFJROTC Instructor, and TSgt Moses Villagomez, AFJROTC Instructor, are diligently working to acquire the experience, knowledge, and training necessary to become successful, responsible, and productive citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors proclaims the week of May 12, 2026, as Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) Week in Solano County and recognizes the outstanding JROTC program at Fairfield High School and the noteworthy accomplishments of the cadets and instructors of the CA-32nd Cadet Corps.
