RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING MAY 6 - 12, 2026, AS NATIONAL NURSES WEEK

WHEREAS, professional nursing organizations, health systems, and communities around the world have traditionally celebrated National Nurses Week every May 6 - 12 to thank and recognize nurses for their dedication to the profession; and

WHEREAS, the International Nurses Association 2026 Nurses Week theme, "*The Power of Nurses*," celebrates the resilience, compassion, and leadership nurses bring to healthcare and highlights the profound impact nurses have on patient outcomes, health culture, and the future of the profession; and

WHEREAS, nursing is the nation's largest healthcare profession, providing compassionate, skilled, and lifesaving care to individuals, families, and communities; and

WHEREAS, nurses serve on the front lines of public health, responding to emerging health threats, supporting preparedness and prevention efforts, and promoting population health through evidence-based practice; and

WHEREAS, Solano County employs approximately sixty nurses and nurse practitioners in a variety of programs and settings, including Family Health Services, Behavioral Health, Child Welfare Services, Foster Care, Older & Disabled Adult Services, Solano County detention facilities, and several Public Health programs including Communicable Disease and Tuberculosis Control, Nurse-Family Partnership, Community IMPACT Nursing, Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention, Healthy Families America, and California Children's Services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors recognizes May 6 - 12, 2026, as National Nurses Week and salutes the efforts of dedicated nurses in the performance of their duties throughout Solano County.
