RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2026 AS CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS MONTH IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, Solano County recognizes that every child matters and joins the 47 California local child support agencies and the nation in recognizing August 2026 as Child Support Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, acknowledging Child Support Awareness Month provides an important opportunity to recognize and highlight the vital role of the California Child Support Program in strengthening children, families, and communities throughout the state and here in Solano County; and

WHEREAS, the California Child Support Program is dedicated to ensuring that children receive the financial and medical support they need to grow, thrive, and reach their full potential. Through child support services provided by local child support agencies, the program promotes parental responsibility and helps improve outcomes for children in the areas of health, education, housing stability, and overall well-being; and

WHEREAS, the Solano County Department of Child Support Services supports children and families by establishing parentage, obtaining accurate child support orders, connecting parents with services that promote family stability and self-sufficiency, and ensuring that child support payments help provide children with the essentials they need to grow, thrive, and succeed; and

WHEREAS, the Solano County Department of Child Support Services remains committed to enhancing the well-being of children by assisting families in navigating the child support process with compassion, empathy, and professionalism, thereby making the process clearer, more manageable, and more achievable for each parent; and

WHEREAS, in Solano County, the Department of Child Support Services continues to have a meaningful impact on the lives of local families. During Federal Fiscal Year 2024–2025, more than \$40 million in child support was distributed to families throughout the county. These funds help ensure that children receive essential necessities such as food, housing, clothing, healthcare, childcare, and educational support; and

WHEREAS, Child Support Awareness Month also serves as a reminder that many families in our community may not be aware of the services and resources available to them. This observance provides an opportunity to increase public awareness, educate families about available support, and encourage parents to take advantage of services that can help meet the needs of their children.
