RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING AUGUST 2-8, 2026, AS NATIONAL HEALTH CENTER WEEK IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, community health centers provide high-quality, affordable, comprehensive primary and preventive health care in our nation's medically underserved communities, delivering value to, and having a significant impact on America's health care system; and

WHEREAS, community health centers, including Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and FQHC Look-Alikes, comprise the nation's largest primary care networking, providing comprehensive, high-quality primary care to approximately 52 million Americans, serving nearly one in every seven people in the United States; and

WHEREAS, community health centers are governed by patient-majority boards, ensuring patients are engaged in their health care decisions; and

WHEREAS, in Solano County, La Clínica de la Raza, Solano County Family Health Services, Community Medical Centers, and CommuniCare+OLE provide care to community members who are low-income, uninsured, or enrolled in Medi-Cal, collectively serving nearly 59,000 Medi-Cal members, equivalent to 12.9% of the county's total population; and

WHEREAS, locally, community health centers have been recognized by Partnership HealthPlan of California for their work to screen patients in a timely manner for cervical cancer, breast cancer, diabetes, and colorectal cancer; and

WHEREAS, the community health center model continues to prove an effective means of overcoming barriers to healthcare access, including geography, income, and insurance status, improving health outcomes and reducing healthcare system costs; and

WHEREAS, local health centers support patients in the community with innovative approaches to meet them where they are by holding mobile mammography events, kindergarten readiness and vaccine clinics, school-based health education, case management, and home visiting services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes August 2-8, 2026, as Solano County National Health Center Week, celebrating this vital partnership between America's Community Health Centers and the communities they serve.
