## **RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF MAY 2026 AS BUILDING SAFETY MONTH IN SOLANO COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, Solano County's continuing efforts to address the critical issues of safety, energy efficiency, water conservation and resilience in the built environment that affect our residents and visitors, both in everyday life and in times of natural disaster, give us confidence that our structures are safe and sound; and

**WHEREAS**, our confidence is achieved through the devotion of vigilant guardians - building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, laborers and others in the construction industry who work year-round to ensure the safe construction of buildings; and

**WHEREAS**, these guardians, dedicated members of the International Code Council, use a governmental consensus process to create and implement the highest-quality codes to protect the public in the buildings where we live, learn, work and play; and

**WHEREAS**, the International Codes, the most widely adopted building safety and fire prevention codes in the nation, are used by cities, counties and states; these modern building safety codes also include safeguards to protect the public from natural disasters such as hurricanes, snowstorms, tornadoes, wild land fires, floods and earthquakes; and

**WHEREAS**, "Built to Last" the theme for Building Safety Month 2026, encourages us all to get involved and raise awareness about building safety on a personal, local and global scale; and

**WHEREAS**, this year, as we observe Building Safety Month, we ask everyone to consider projects to improve building safety at home and in the community, and to acknowledge the essential services provided to all of us by local and state building departments, fire prevention bureaus and federal agencies in protecting lives and property.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes the month of May 2026 as Building Safety Month in Solano County and encourages residents to join communities across America in raising the awareness of the importance of building safety.
