RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE DIRECTOR OF GENERAL SERVICES OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE, AMEND, AND TERMINATE STANDARDIZED MONTH-TO-MONTH COUNTY HANGAR USE AGREEMENTS FOR THE NUT TREE AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the County of Solano operates the Nut Tree Airport for the service and benefit of the community; and

WHEREAS, the County of Solano owns and operates County airport facilities, including aircraft hangars and related improvements (“Airport Facilities”); and

WHEREAS, Airport Facilities are made available to members of the public and aviation tenants for aircraft storage under month-to-month hangar use agreements; and

WHEREAS, such month-to-month agreements are administrative in nature, standardized in form, revocable upon notice, and do not create long-term real property interests; and

WHEREAS, requiring individual Board approval for each month-to-month agreement is administratively burdensome and may delay occupancy and efficient operation of Airport Facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to delegate authority to execute such agreements to ensure efficient management and operation of County Airport Facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors hereby delegates authority to the Director of General Services, or designee, to execute, amend, and terminate standardized, agreements for month-to-month use of County-owned Airport Facilities, provided that such agreements:

1. Are on forms approved by County Counsel;
2. Are consistent with Board-approved rates, fees and policies;
3. Do not exceed \$10,000 per month; and
4. Do not exceed a cumulative term of ten years.
