## RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING JUNE 12, 2026, AS WOMEN VETERANS RECOGNITION DAY IN SOLANO COUNTY TO HONOR THE INVALUABLE CONTRIBUTIONS AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF WOMEN VETERANS AND SERVICEWOMEN, AND EXPRESS GRATITUDE FOR THEIR SELFLESS DEDICATION TO DUTY
