70+ Solano County Partner Agencies receive bulk food

Food Insecurity in Solano County

- The Food Bank is seeing more than 26,000 households visit distribution sites on average each month in Solano County
- 15 million pounds of food was distributed to Solano County residents last year

Food Bank's Contributions Matter

- Donations help provide more than 2,700,000 monthly meals to residents
- The Food Bank provides healthy meals to clients
- Over 65% of food distributed is fresh produce, dairy and protein
- Community of 7,000 volunteers served more than 100,000 hours last year
- Partnerships with more than 245 nonprofit agencies to provide food assistance
- One dollar provides enough food for at least two meals
- 97 cents of every dollar donated goes directly to food programs

Past Food Fight Results / County Outcomes




About the Counties Care Food Fight / 2024 results

- Departments hosted unique events (raffles, silent auctions, prepared food)
- Solano County raised \$58,833 in 2024
- Average donation was \$19.78 per employee

Outcomes over the past 21 years

- Solano County employees have raised a combined \$789,123
- Contra Costa employees have raised a combined \$1.45 million
- The Food Fight has raised more than \$2.6 million for the Food Bank
