## **RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF MAY 12, 2026, AS JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) WEEK AND RECOGNIZING VANDEN HIGH SCHOOL'S 20011 CADET GROUP JROTC PROGRAM IN SOLANO COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps program at Vanden High School, known as the CA-20011 Cadet Group, has 111 cadets enrolled and is a leadership program that greatly benefits the young people of Solano County; and

**WHEREAS**, cadets at Vanden High School in 2025-26 donated a total of 1,720 hours of community service to their school and community and achieved an overall rating of "Exceeds Standards" with a perfect score of 100% on their Unit Evaluation, were awarded the Distinguished Unit Award with Merit in 2024-25, and participated in Junior ROTC and other extracurricular activities throughout the school year; and

**WHEREAS**, Vanden's cadets participated in numerous community activities including the Foxboro and Center Elementary Fall Festivals, Tuskegee Airman Birthday Celebration, Fairfield Adopt-A-Street program, Fairfield Veterans Day Parade, and the Vacaville American Legion Holiday Meal Preparation; and

**WHEREAS**, Vanden High School cadets assisted in various fundraising efforts for some worthy causes, including purchasing, collecting and donating 50 Christmas gifts for Solano County foster children; and

**WHEREAS**, several Vanden fourth-year cadets have been accepted to universities with plans to study engineering, nursing, and biological sciences, several with plans to enlist in the US Air Force, and one enlisting in the US Navy with plans to become a commissioned officer; and

**WHEREAS**, the cadets at Vanden High School willingly joined the Junior ROTC program and accepted the objectives of personal responsibility, self-reliance, service to others, and took on leadership roles at school, in Junior ROTC activities, and in their daily lives; and

**WHEREAS**, the cadets at Vanden High School, under the guidance and leadership of their dedicated instructors Master Sergeant Khafiz Gondry and Master Sergeant Matthew Walsh are diligently working toward acquiring the experience and knowledge to become involved and productive citizens.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors recognizes the outstanding Junior ROTC program at Vanden High School and the fine accomplishments of the cadets in the CA-20011 Cadet Group.
