**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
AUTHORIZING THE SOLANO COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY, OR HER
DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND RELATED DOCUMENTS TO
THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
FOR THE VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

Whereas, the County of Solano desires to continue a Victim Witness Assistance Program to be supported with Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Victim Assistance Formula Grant Program funds authorized by the Victims of Crime Act of 1984 as amended, 42 U.S.C. 10601, et seq.; and

Whereas, the Solano County District Attorney seeks to submit a grant request for award to the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) in the amount of \$775,161 for the period of October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027.

Therefore, Be it Resolved, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Solano County District Attorney, or her designee, to submit a grant application and related documents to the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) Victim/Witness Assistance Program in the amount of \$775,161 for the period of October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027.
