RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF MAY 12, 2026, AS JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) WEEK AND RECOGNIZING ARMIJO HIGH SCHOOL'S 71st CADET GROUP JROTC PROGRAM IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps program at Armijo High School, known as the 71st Cadet Group, has 75 cadets enrolled and is a leadership program that is of great benefit to the young people of Solano County; and

WHEREAS, cadets at Armijo High School in academic year 2025-2026 contributed to their school and community, while maintaining their academic workload, and participating in Junior ROTC and other extracurricular activities throughout the school year; and

WHEREAS, Armijo's cadets performed over 900 hours of organized volunteer activities, such as removing trash and debris from local creeks as part of fall Coast and Creek Cleanup effort; removing trash and debris from around the Armijo High School campus and Solano County Parks; volunteering to assist with school sporting events; collecting pet food and toys for the local ASPCA; and presenting the colors at events on and off campus;

WHEREAS, the cadets at Armijo High School have assisted other students by tutoring them and helping them gain understanding of the various academic subjects and courses required to graduate; and conducting awareness presentations to students at the local middle schools; and

WHEREAS, Armijo's cadets showed their esprit de corps and teamwork – hallmarks of the military profession – by leading the school in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance as well as being responsible for raising and lowering the flag each day; marching in Fairfield's Veterans Day Parade, presenting the Colors at a variety of local events, including the Armijo High Senior awards event and the district-wide Special Olympics Basketball Tournament; and

WHEREAS, the cadets at Armijo High School willingly joined the Junior ROTC program and accepted the objectives of personal responsibility, self-reliance, service to others, and took on leadership roles at school, in Junior ROTC activities, and in their daily lives; and

WHEREAS, the cadets at Armijo High School, under the guidance and leadership of their dedicated instructors Captain Matt Gregory and Technical Sergeant Rodney Hicks, are diligently working toward acquiring the experience and knowledge to become involved and productive citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors recognizes the outstanding Junior ROTC program at Armijo High School and the fine accomplishments of the cadets in the 71st Cadet Group.
