She joined the Solano County Sheriff's Office as an Accounting Technician on July 29, 2018, before promoting to Accounting Supervisor with the Auditor-Controller's Office on July 11, 2021. Diana returned to the Sheriff's Office as a Clerical Operations Manager on September 17, 2023, where she served until her retirement; and
